## **Application On Untreated Wood:**

- 1. The surface must be clean, dry and sound. Remove dirt, dust, mould, algae and moss growth and loose parts. Sanding is not necessary, only when a smooth result is desired.
- 2. Clean with Fluxaf Pro-Clean.
- 3. Stir the contents thoroughly.
- Use a flat brush, buckshot or roller. Apply in the longitudinal direction of the wood grain for a good finish.
- Apply first coat.
  The second coat The second coat can only be applied after complete drying of first coat.
- 6. We recommend applying two coats to untreated wood.
- 7. The applied coat slowly becomes evenly mattified over time.

Duration of wood protection depends on the quality of the wood, correct pre-treatment, execution of painting, maintenance, and intensity of load. Always do a test area first to see if you get the desired finish and this will vary on different wood.

## Surface Maintenance:

To make best use of the paintwork, the surface should be cleaned and maintained annually. The surface can be cleaned by gently wiping it. Use a damp cleaning cloth or soft sponge for this purpose. Rough brushing and strong detergents should be avoided.

## Tools:

Flat brush, buckshot or roller suitable for solvent-based paint.
